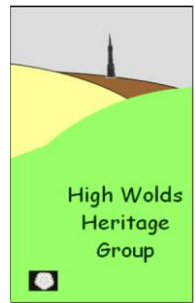


A Guided walk by Steve Bence round some of the ancient sites of the Wolds – Sat 10th May
